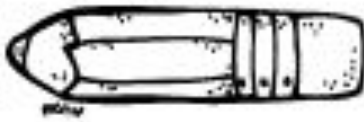

<u>What's That Word?!</u> Choose 5 vocabulary words that you did not understand in the story. Write down the definition of that word.	<u>The Sequel</u> Pretend the author wrote a second book using all of the same characters. What would the book cover look like? What would it be about?	<u>COMPARE & CONTRAST</u> Compare and contrast 2 things from your story. How are they the same and different? You may choose characters or settings.
<u>TALK SHOW</u> Write 5 questions you would like to ask the author. What are you still wondering? What would you like to learn more about?	<u>SUMMARY</u> Write a brief summary about your story. Include the main ideas, facts, and details from the story.	<u>MOVIE POSTER</u> Imagine your book was turned into a movie. What would the movie poster look like? What changes would you make from the book?
<u>COMIC STRIP</u> Choose your favorite chapter from the book and create a comic strip showing the events in order.	<u>Connections</u> Make a connection between something you read and something from your life, another text, or the world around you.	<u>Character Study</u> Choose one character from your book and list one word that describes them. Use evidence from the book to support your decision.

Read, read, read! This summer after you finish reading pick one of the activities to complete above. In total you will need to complete three activities. One for each book. Remember that they have to be in a row or diagonal.
