GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Coordinate campus functions and events
- Serve with parents, faculty, and student groups, as requested, in advancing educational and related activities and objectives.
- Demonstrates prompt and regular attendance.
- May supervise the day-to-day operations and serve as principal designee in the principal's absence.
- Share in managing discipline for grades K-8 and deal with special cases as necessary.
- Keeps the principal apprised of activities, situations, and developments that affect the school operation.
- Supervise teachers and departments as assigned by the principal.

- Explain and interpret curriculum/instructional goals and objectives to teachers, parents, and the community.
- Assists with the organization and implementation of staff development.
- Assists in the supervision of the extracurricular program.
- Assists with safeguarding the health, safety and welfare of students.
- Supervises student activities, assemblies and other activities.
- Assists in organizing student activities.
- Assists with the supervision of student orientation, registration, and scheduling.
- Assists with the administration and supervision of the total school program in accordance with applicable regulations.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the appropriate administrator.
- Assist with federal programs as a federal program coordinator.
- Maintain and model high standards of professionalism.
