Some teachers have roles of Japanese and English curriculum development, ESOL, Gifted, SPED, Federal Program, and Testing coordinators. Four Deans to represent Immersion Program (their roles are part-time): Dean of School Community, Dean of Japanese, Dean of English, and Dean of Education.

2) Some of the educational services such as SPED Evaluation, OT, and Speech Therapy are funded by the Federal Programs.

3) Mortgage (interest and Principal): \$18k per month; 4% of State Funds
